Appeal for II. exhibition of works of art in small format at Kreativhof Lehmberg

Topic: Being a pig! - Small format Exhibition from 26 August – 23 September 2018

Eligibility requirements:

Every artist over the age of 24 and holding German or any other European nationality is encouraged to submit self-made works of art concerning the abovementioned topic. Exhibits should be sent by post; email submissions will not be \ accepted.

Each artist may submit up to two exhibits in a maximum format of 20 cm x 28 cm. The exhibits shall be pulled on cardboard or pasteboard, with a surrounding border of 0,5 cm. The total format of each exhibit must not surpass the format of 21 cm x 29 cm.

Each exhibit needs to bear the artist's complete postal and e-mail address, the exhibit title (if relevant) and the sales price (legible!) on the back of the paperboard!

The topic can be interpreted freely but creative intention and a link to the topic need to be apparent. A short statement regarding the exhibits is desirable (max. 400 characters).

All exhibits using two-dimensional, artistic techniques are welcome (painting, collage, cartoon, chart/graphic, photography, texts, textiles, etc.)

Exhibited works can be offered for sale. In case of sale, a 15% handling fee will be deducted from the selling price.

The organizer will produce an catalogue accompanying the exhibition. The catalogue will be available in German and have a DIN A4 format (29,7 cm x 21 cm). All exhibiting artists will receive a free copy of the catalogue. Upon submission of your works, please enclose stamps amounting to $4 \in$ (Germany) and 5,10 \in (Europe without Germany) for the return of your exhibits, your copy of the catalogue and packaging. If you do not enclose the stamps required, your works will not be considered for the exhibition and they cannot be returned.

Works of art that do not have a discernible reference to the topic, that discriminate in any way against third parties, that violate applicable law or that do not meet the requirements of this call for submissions will be excluded from the project without reimbursement of costs.

By submitting their contributions, the submitting artists agree to the current conditions for participation and authorize the organizer to publish, diffuse and represent their works free of charge in all respective media for news coverage and public relations. The artists assure that they are the proprietary holders of copyrights pertaining to the submitted works of art and that there are no arrangements with third parties, which can plead exploitation rights therefrom.

The works of art will be exhibited at the Kreativhof Lehmberg, a former farm. In line with the artistic theme of this call for submissions, the exhibition room is transformed former pigsty.

Information on the art activity for "shadow children", co-financed through art works donated to the 2017 exhibition "Sheep"

Sales revenue from works donated to the 2017 exhibition "Sheep" will be used to co-finance a weekend art activity for so-called "shadow children" in July 2018. Shadow children are children whose brother or sister suffers from a severe illness and so becomes unintentionally the center of family life. As a consequence, the healthy children must comply with the family's daily routine and appointments of their sick siblings to the effect that their childhood is severely impacted.

During the art activity, we want to give these "shadow children" the opportunity to take center stage. We organize a creative weekend with typographies, games and fun activities. The programme includes an overnight stay and a closing exhibition at which the young artists can present their graphic art works to their families and friends.
